MISSION:

Our goal is to respond to the needs of the community by providing students the opportunity to broaden their academic options through credit retrieval or academic enrichment by taking required courses.

High School courses offered include the following: Driver's Education, PE I and II, Lifetime Sports, Health, English I, II, III, IV, Algebra IA, IB, I, Intuitive Geometry, Geometry, World History, US History, and Government.

Middle School Courses offered are: English 6, 7, and 8. Math 6, 7, 8, and Reading.

DISCIPLINE:

Regulations governing student behavior during the regular school year apply to the summer school program. **Violation of any discipline regulation may include an automatic withdrawal from the summer school program with NO refund.** It may also include the recommendation to an alternative behavior program or the recommendation for expulsion. **ALL DISCIPLINE POLICIES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED!**

- Students and parents, please go over the Summer School Rules together.

Verbal and/or physical altercations = automatic withdrawal without receiving credit or a refund. The student may also be referred to an alternative behavior program for the forthcoming year.

Coronado Summer School is a closed campus. **No students are allowed to go to their vehicles during classes or at break.** Students will receive one 15 minute break during the school day. Students will be able to enjoy vending machines and snack booths located in the quad.

Breaks: One 15 break will be scheduled between 9:00 and 10:00. Snacks and drinks will be sold in the quad.

ATTENDANCE IS CRUCIAL!!

- If you are absent three days from summer school, you will be withdrawn with NO credit and NO refund.
- Students are expected to be on time to class in the morning and after the break. The tardy policy states that **three tardies equal a one day absence.**

Summer School Rules

1. NO food or drink in the classroom. This includes bottled water. During break students will have access to vending machines/tables selling food and drinks.
2. NO cell phone use in the classroom. Cell phones will be confiscated by the teacher and brought up to the summer school office. A parent MUST come to pick the cell phone up. You may use cell phones during the break in the quad.
3. Dress Code:
 - Girls – Sleeves must be at least 3 inches
No low cut tops/bare midriffs
Shorts/Skirts must be finger tip length
 - Boys – No sagging
No caps/hoodies, etc
No chains or bandanas

There is no in-house nor shirts/shorts to change into. A parent will be notified to pick you up and it will count as an absence.

5. Absences – will be automatically withdrawn on 3rd absence. No Refund and No Credit!!
